Study questions for med term test on Acts chapters 1-14. Test will be passed out or obtained on line at the class upload site, and made available on April 12th. Students will have one week to complete the test, and return it to me via email or hand delivered on April 19th. Final test will be made available on May 10th, last day of class, and returned no later than May 17th. Tests will be docked one full grade for late return.

Questions for Study

1. Be able to provide name of author and recipient of the book of Acts

2. Trace the promise of the coming church (Matt. 16:18) to the establishment of the church with such passages as Mark 9:1, Acts 1:6-8, and Acts 2:1-4, with emphasis upon the coming of the "promised Spirit" – and that the church was established on Pentecost of Acts 2

3. Know the name of the apostle chosen to replace Judas Iscariot.

- 4. Know the two-fold qualification of someone to be an apostle, Acts 1:21-22
- 5. Provide a brief outline of Peter's sermon in Acts 2:19 ff.:
 - 1. The miracle explained, 14-21;
 - 2. Jesus proclaimed as Lord and Christ, 22-35
 - (A) His resurrection declared, 22-24;
 - (B) The resurrection of Christ predicted by David, 25-31;
 - (C) The resurrection of Jesus attested by the twelve, 32;
 - (D) Jesus exalted to the throne of God, 33-36;
 - 3. The people exhorted to save themselves, 37-40;

6. How does Acts 3:19 parallel Acts 2:38?

7. Be able to fill in blanks in Acts 4:12: Neither is there <u>salvation</u> in any other: for there is <u>none other name</u> under heaven given among men, whereby we <u>must be saved</u>

8. Be able to give the background for the occasion of Barnabas' generous gift, and what the brethren were willing to do on that occasion -i.e. vs. 32

9. Be able to name the couple who lie in Acts 5, and TO WHOM they lied, and their punishment

10. What was the occasion for the selection of the 7 men to serve in Acts chapter 6

11. Who was the first martyr – Stephen

12. We are first introduced to Saul under what circumstances? Acts 7:58

13. What two cases of conversion do we have in chapter 8? Who was the evangelist? Who was the protagonist in the first example? (Simon the Sorcerer).

14. Know why Phillip had to send to Jerusalem to get Peter and John to come down to Samaria with regard to the Holy Spirit and miracles

15. What did Simon attempt to do that put his soul in danger? What was he told to do?

16. What passage was the eunuch reading from upon Phillip's arrival?

17. Where had the eunuch come FROM, and to where was he headed upon Phillip's arrival?

18. Be aware of some of the details of Saul's conversion: where was he headed, and why? Who came to him to teach him and baptize him? What did Saul do immediately after his baptism, and in what city?

19. What disciple was willing to take Saul and bring him to the apostles?

20. What was Saul's home town? Tarsus

21. Chapter nine tells of Peter's work in what city? Lydda.

22. What city lay close to Lydda and was the occasion for the raising of what woman? Close to Joppa, and the raising of Tabitha, whose name was Dorcas.

- 23. Chapter 10 has to do with the conversion of what man? Cornelius
- 24. What was unusual about the case of Peter going to Cornelius? He was a Gentile
- 25. What was the significance of the vision God gave to Peter?
- 26. What do we now about Cornelius? 10:1-2
- 27. In chapter 11 we learn that Peter was sent to Cornelius to do what? "Speak words" by which he would be saved.
- 28. What "sign" reminded Peter of the reception of the H.S. on the part of the apostles?

29. How do we know that Cornelius was not saved when the H.S. came upon him? Because Peter was sent to speak words by which he would be saved (11:14).

- 30. Who did Herod kill in chapter 12? James the brother of John
- 31. Who did Herod attempt to kill? And why did Herod seek to kill him? Peter, and because it pleased the Jews

- 34. List the prophets and teachers who were in Antioch (13:1)
- 35. Who travelled with Saul on his first missionary journey? Barnabas and John Mark
- 36. Who turned back and when? John Mark, upon their departure from Cyprus

37. Be able to locate on a map the cities along Paul's route of Paul's 1st missionary journey, beginning with the departure from Antioch: Seleucia, Salamis, Paphos, Perga, Antioch of Pisidia, Iconium, Lystra, Derbe, Perga, and Attalia.

- 38. Who was the false prophet at Paphos; he had two names? Barjesus and Elymas.
- 39. Who was the proconsul or deputy at Paphos? Sergius Paulus
- 40. In what city did the citizens think Paul and Barnabas were the 'gods' from heaven? Lystra
- 41. What names of what 'gods' did they give Paul and Barnabas?
- 42. Upon completion of the 1st missionary journey, they returned to what city? Antioch
- 43. What did they do upon arriving home? They rehearsed all things God had done through them.
