

***A SYLLABUS FOR FIRST AND SECOND
SAMUEL***

1 Samuel 1:8; 2:2; 3:4; 4:11; 6:1; 7:15; 8:5; 10:25; 14:6; 15:22; 17:37; 19:24b; 23:12; 25:1a; 31:4b.

2 Samuel 3:10; 5:4; 7:5; 12:7; 22:32-33.

Write a five-page introduction to 1 Samuel and one to 2 Samuel that you can use in a class. The former assignment is for those who are taking the course for a certificate, but for the graduate diploma, a ten-page intro for each book is required.
