## REQUIREMENTS:

Each student will be required to pay attention to the instructor, to follow along in the handouts, to do any required reading and assignments outside of class, and to actively participate in class.

Students taking the class toward the **M.O.S.T. Certificate** must write a five page paper [double spaced, Times New Roman 12 pt.] on either the harmonizing of the Gospels, the role of the synagogue in the First Century, the role of the temple in the First Century, the Herods, the procurators, the Jewish sects, or overiewing secular sources for the study of the First Century.

Students taking the class for the **M.O.S.T. Advanced Diploma** must write a seven page paper [double spaced, Times New Roman 12 pt.] on either the harmonizing of the Gospels, the role of the synagogue in the First Century, the role of the temple in the First Century, the Herods, the procurators, the Jewish sects, or overiewing secular sources for the study of the First Century.

Only students who are **auditing** are exempt from the outside assignments and final exam; however, they may take part if they desire.
