- 02. HIGHERS' TECHNIQUE...Subject applied to five areas: Definitions, Popular Ideas, Truth, Exposure of Error, and Plea to follow truth today in honor of Alan E. Highers, Henderson, Tn.
- 03. POSITIVE...Subject applied in 'This Is' manner
- 04. NEGATIVE...Subject applied in 'This Is Not' manner
- 05. COMPARISON...Subject applied with rule 'This is like that in the following

ways'

06. CONTRAST...Subject applied with rule 'This is different from that in the

following ways'

- 07. SPACE...Subject applied to certain groups (common elements) of people
- 08. ARGUMENTATION...Subject applied with rules: Major Premise Statement, Minor

Premise Statement, and Conclusion Obligated from MjP. & MiP.

09. ACROSTIC...Subject applied using letters of alphabet, spelling out word(s)

of significance

10. BIBLE EVENT /APPLICATION...Subject selects specific Biblical

event, developing major points of application

from it

11. ONE-POINT / APPLICATION...Subject selects one verse of Scripture and

applies one point to the audience

12. TEXT / APPLICATION...Subject choses a group of Scriptures and applies a

few major points from the group

13. QUESTION & ANSWER...Subject is taught by asking and answering questions in

each major point:

Who, What, Why, When, Where, How, Can, Will, Is, Should, Would, May, Shall, etc.

14. LOGICAL...Subject applied by developing the Cause, The Effect and the

Solution (if subject discussed is a problem)

15. EXPOSITORY...Subject applied in four major points: General Background,

Specific Context, Exposure of Truth, and Application of the Truth

16. OBJECT / APPLICATION...Subject applied in using an object from which to

draw major points of application to audience

(Comparison/Contrast #5,#6, useful as major points)

17. REVIEW...Subject applied by presenting the highlights of events,

- 96. PARODY PRESENTATION....Subject is presented in reversal form emphasizing the terribleness of untruth(re-write text in reversal) --use poem, storylines, satire--be sure audience understands the basic truth of subject, first (from Robert Waggoner of Selma, Ala. 'Building Better Christian Homes', 'God and Our Nation' 1/21/92)
- 97. REALITY-PRACTICAL/HYPOTHETICAL....Subject is first presented by facts, and theory (hypothetical); finally, the reality of the subject is delivered e.g. 'in view of the judgment this (subject) is going to be acceptable or condemned', 'God's will about (this) is'

 (from R.V.Rawson, Jr. of Kosciusko, Ms., 1/26/92)
- 98. TREND PATTERN.....Subject is viewed from perspective of the trend in which it is found and in light of former trends both biblical and secular; contrast to the fads of religious trends which are unauthorized by the Lord
- 99. CIVIL WAR APPROACH....Subject presented by advancing with strengths then followed by Scriptural, lighter, banter followed by a quick return (lurch) forward in the setting forth of proper conclusions
- 100. THE 'ALRIGHT-TILL' CONTRAST....Subject's good points are exposed 'till' contrasted with poignant (sharp) problems which ultimately will derail any good expectation.
- 101. EXAMPLE PLUS....Subject chosen on the basis of an example which is followed by your major points (ck. Topical)(e.g. Saul's assumption of Levite Priests duties--I. God's Specific Rules, II. Saul Disobeys III. Applications to New Testament Christianity)
- 102. 'IDENTIFYING WITH' DYNAMIC....Subject is a person who is being identified with something or someone other than Christ Jesus, the Lord. Major Points present the metaphorical comparisons in this dynamic. Show the need to reject from practice such habits as would identify a Christian as less than, or more than, Christ-Follower.
- 103. EVALUATION REPAIR....Subject is presented in three senses within the sermon: I. The Perfectly Desirable Situation, II. The Reality of the Situation as it actually happened, III. The Necessary Changes Explained which will result in a different(and presumably better) outcome the

next time the situation occurs.

- 104. ROUTE PLAN.....Subject is emotional(Runaway Pace) and is approached by Exposing That You Are Aware of Runaway Topic, I. Emotional Problem then, Explore Solutions God Has Taught in a question/answer style II. Solutions A. What is the problem? B. Why is this a problem (to God)? C. How should we progress to solve this problem?
- 105. ANALOGY SUPREME...Subject presented by use of an overwhelming analogy which extols and accentuates the major point being made(e.g. I. We Reap The Fruit of The Seed We Sow (Gal. 6:6-9) A.etc. Analogy to every suitable
- 106. GRAND OPENING & RIT..CLOSE...Subject presented by topical(ck.#1) w/Major Point I. as a grand opening II. in multiple questions and III. in a retiring conclusion. No introduction and ever so brief conclusion
- 107. BLACK'S MAJOR CONTRAST DELIVERY...Subject is of supreme value and is contrasted to major points each of which is a good value within itself yet pales when contrasted to the Subject (e.g. I. Christ Is The Greater A. Than Any Historical person, date, or event B. Earth's Wonderment as located in Universe C. Than All Teachers of Past D. Than Any Suffering One E. Than Any Resurrection. The title is 'Behold The Man' and is chosen late in the sermon development
- I. Definition of Subject II. Illustrating Subject's Value or Avalue III. Example of Subject's worth or lack of worth (idea from Pat Hardeman,nephew of N.B. Hardeman who sounded and reasoned much like him,2-10-93, at F-HU lectureship at event of Pat's lessons on Deity of Christ From Book of John) Use of metaphors 1)different words express spiritual qualities 2)likeness(similes) examined 3)Attributes higher than common usage of that word now used as metaphor(Artistotle,Sostner) It is sensible and has pronouns agreeing with subject nouns every time
- 109. A COMPELLING POOL...Subject delivered with compelling seriousness in major point I. and pool of examples establishing serious qualities in major point II.
- 110. ASPECTS SOUGHT...Subject presented in light of relationships which proceed from subject(aspects of the subject) The conclusion may come in first point with aspects explored in subsequent points
- 111. CONCLUSION FIRST...Subject presented with conclusion being first point and remaining major points reinforcing subject's importance to God and

- 243. MAIN IDEAL and DETAILS.....Subject is presented by Main Ideal of the topic followed by details which justify the importance of the topic (e.g. GOD, 1. Detail: Creator, Genesis 1.1.2. Detail Isaiah 55:8-9 3. Detail 2 Corinthians 5:10)March 16, 2014......
- 244. HOW DO YOU FEEL?Subject is presented with the effects of life's trials followed by question 'What do you hope next?' (e.g. How do you feel about sin? 2. What do you hope to be the next effect upon your life and your soul?)March 16, 2014)
- 245. OLIVIA'S PROVIDENTIAL TOUCH......Subject is presented in a way that basic questions can not find an answer followed by the 2nd point about our looking up to God's overall plan which, of course, may not be known here below, but answered by our loving God for hope which is given by the act of providence (e.g. Romans 8:28-32; I. May not understand situations at hand II. We know all things work together for good III. For them that love God and are the called according to His purpose IV. May not yet be a certainty, but hope is present for sure, thank God)May 24, 2014.....
- 246. JOHN HALL BASICS...Subject is the presentation of the most important, serious, thought provoking topic as to its cause or causes and results (e.g. Mercy of God, I. Heart of God is filled with greater love than man....Isaiah 40:31...life applications....of Mt. Ida, AR, now living near Rogers, AR and mortician with local funeral home, too....as of August 7, 2014. He and wife relocated to further northwestern AR by June, 2015 and he went back to preach at Glendale after 30 years removed in early 2016.
- 247. BEGINNING AT THE BEGINNING.....Subject is about 'how' to possibly reach those refusing to consider the information I.John 7:17 Must Will to do His Will II. Fear will cause the will to change (John 12:48) Judgment is Coming III. Love will cause the will to melt (John 14:15) love Him and keep his commands The will of man has to agree to be taught anything and fear and love are the two beginning motivations.April 14, 2015......
- 248. JOHNSON'S PROVERB EXTRA....Subject opens with a life's popular slogan or proverb (e.g. 'Play With Fire and You Will Get Burned' use of toics such as Deceit, Lack of Faith, Out of Control (Anger) and Worldly Thoughts....in honor of Hal Johnson formerly of Courtland and today of Sardis church 4/18/15
- 249. QUESTIONS EXTEND KNOWLEDGE.....Subject is continued with questions (e.g. How did you get this understanding? What reading idd you do to get this understanding?; Would you allow me to share another understanding?).... April 18, 2015;247
- 250. THE DOUBTFUL LADEN LIFE.....Subject of God's ability to Forgive is doubted to Extremes (e.g. Challenges to God's Promises...(I John 1:3-4; 9) Challenges ability to be closer via prayer (I John 1:9; Philippians 4:6-7)

- 251. CONNECTOR WORDS....Subject is described by use of Poems, Prose, Song Stanza Proverbs, (e.g. 'Assembed for memorial of a loved one...'if you go first and I remain', Adjustments must be made----The Turtle and the Rabbit's Race----All of life experiences can improve---little train engine sounds like 'I think I can', I think I can up the ill and 'I knew I could, I knew I could' going down the hill....in honor of John Flowers of Senatobia, 90 years of age at current time 6/12/15).
- 252. SEARCHING OUT THE ESSENCE....Subject is subjected to intensive investigation of the most basic cause (love, hate, worldy choices---I John 4---we love Him who first loved us Why? Because good service deserves respect in return 3) Why? We know sawing off the limb behind you causes hurt for us! 4) Why? A fall is sure to happen and hurts happen then and Do we desire those hurts? Surely Not as we consider the essence.
- 253. CREATING CONVICTION -R-T-J.....Subject is chosen which emphasize Righteousness, Tempernance and Judgment to Come(e.g. Acts 24:25 Felix reaction to those subjects spoken by Paul, the apostle of Jesus Christ in his trial) after Gospel meeting with Jeremy Houck, 7/2016
- 254. SYNECDOCHE METHODOLOGY....Subject is introduced and quickly another subject is introduced of equal rank of importance; a part is made to stand for the whole (synecdoche) (e.g. Hearing for salvation Eph 1:14; believing for salvation (Romans 10:10); repentance (Ac 11:18); confession (Rom 10:10) Baptism (1 Peter 3:21) Watching and Praying (Mt. 26:41); obeying (Heb 5:8-9)..etc. Etc. x 42 in New Testament.
- 255. FOREVERS......Subjects relating to earthly life may live on in the memory of others even after illness forbidden the person's outage in the community or even after death: Common Sense; Faith; Hope; Humility; Happiness; Integrity; Peace of Mind; Patience; Honor; Influence; Respect; Truth, Wisdom are among the lasting effects in others' memories. (Ex: The 'dash' between one's birth date and death date may well be the memory of Truth or Dishonesty in that person's lifetime) 8/2017
- 256. CONTEXTUAL NECESSITIES....Subject may be without proper understanding if the context of it is left out of the application. E.g. Noah and the Ark preparation was made in the patriarchal period of the Old Testament time; further the Apostles of Christ are encouraged by Jesus teaching them the Holy Spirit would come to them and guide THEM into all truth (John 16:13 as well as chapters 14 thru 17). We teach that truth to all men today just as it was given or otherwise we serve only our own bellies (Romans 1616-18). 3/2018
- 257. DEFINITION NECESSITIES.... Subject may be properly presented only when the original meaning of words used in Scripture are presented today. E.g. Baptism (Col. 2:12) and burial is used to describe it. 5/2019

258, DARKNESS OF STORY CONFIRMED....Subject is presented from opposite of good till ending of presentation wherein the better choice is confirmed. E.g. Bad choices; Immorality vs. purity; despair vs hope (Romans 8:24) 3/2020
