TEXTBOOKS:

The Holy Bible (King James Version or America Standard Version)

REQUIREMENTS:

Each student will be required to do the outside reading assignments, to pay attention to the instructor, to take thorough notes, and to read as called upon.

Each student will be required to write a twenty-one section paper, with one (MOST Certificate) or two (Advanced Diploma) pages devoted to each of the sections of the book of Job--which will be introduced in the first class session. On the narrative sections, the student will recount what has taken place. On the speech sections, the student will note how the speech relates to the other speeches--especially those just prior, and what each speaker got right or wrong. The papers must be typed in Times New Roman 12 pt. and submitted via PDF to the instructor. For students who had this assignment in the two-year program; they may add one page to each section to take advantage of and to augment their earlier work.

GRADING:

The grades will be weighted thus:

One paper 100%

Bonus points, participation, and attitude can help to push borderline grades upward.
